The Levantines were a small minority concentrated in the cities of the Ottoman Empire, but their influence on commerce, ideas and industrialisation was considerable. We would like to explore this theme in the conference and are keen to attract new and recent research. The scale and scope of their activities was as varied as the Levantines themselves. They worked both in small shops and giant factory complexes and their legacy survives in their buildings and networks that were forged before the Turkish Republic was declared in 1923. Some Levantines adapted to this watershed and a few have continued to call Turkey their home. We are happy to accept proposals across a wide chronological, geographic and thematic spectrum.
